Notice is hereby given that Mid Sound Fisheries Enhancement Group (Mid Sound) will accept sealed bids addressed to Troy Fields - Mid Sound Fisheries Enhancement Group, 7400 Sandpoint Way NE, Suite 202N, Seattle, WA 98115 until 2:00 pm local time on Tuesday, April 30th, 2013. Mid Sound will not consider bids received after that time and date. There will NOT be a public opening and reading of bids.

Bid proposals may be sent by mail or hand delivered to the above address, or emailed to troy@midsoundfisheries.org no later 2:00pm local time on April 30th, 2013. The envelope shall be plainly marked with "SEALED BID for Gorst Creek Project", and shall clearly indicate the name and address of the bidder.

This project will restore the in-stream and riparian habitat in 1200 linear feet of Gorst Creek located adjacent to 4153 West Belfair Valley Road. The project includes bank stabilization and installation of LWD. Work within the OHWM is restricted to June 15th – September 30th, 2013 with exact dates to be determined by permits.

This contract involves "public work". Workers shall receive the prevailing rate of wage pursuant to the Prevailing Wages on Public Works Act (Chapter 39.12 RCW)

Plans & Specifications: All documentation will be delivered electronically via email provided. The contractor is responsible for ensuring they have received all required documentation. Hard copies of all documents are available upon request for a \$25 fee.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid bond in the form of certified check, cashier's check or bid bond (with authorized surety company as surety) made payable to Mid Sound Fisheries

Enhancement Group in an amount not less than 5% of the amount of bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract within the time stated in the specifications, the bid bond shall be forfeited to Mid Sound Fisheries Enhancement Group.

A pre-bid site visit is not required, although it is highly recommended. Please contact the project manager to arrange a time prior to April 16th 2013.

The Mid Sound Fisheries Enhancement Group reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities and informalities in the bidding process. No bidder may withdraw their bid after the hour set for bid closing thereof or before award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding thirty (30) days.
